The Fall River Housing Authority (FRHA) is seeking qualified applicants for the position of **Director of Facilities Management**. The Director of Facilities Management is the lead administrative person responsible for the physical plan of the Fall River Housing Authority which includes: planning, scheduling major repairs, modernization initiatives and major maintenance to address vacancy turnover responsibilities.

Additionally, the Director of Facilities Management serves as part of the senior management team, along with the Executive Director, Deputy Executive Director for Finance & Leased Housing, and Director of Field Operations, who are responsible for establishing and implementing the short-term and long-term goals, including Modernization and Capital Funding needs as well as other objectives for the Authority.

Minimum qualifications: Bachelor's degree with six or more years experience with assisted housing programs or other HUD/Government programs.

The salary for this position is determined in accordance with the Fall River Housing Authority's annual budget as approved by the FRHA Board of Commissioners. Suggested salary range is \$100,303.00 to \$108,876.00.
